

CIEH PREPARING TO TEACH IN THE LIFELONG LEARNING SECTOR LEVEL 3 (PTLLS) COURSE OUTLINE

Course Duration: 5 days

Suitable candidates and pre requisitions: This qualification has been developed for anyone entering teaching or training roles or already in service who needs to achieve the minimum threshold status as a teacher in the lifelong learning sector; that is, adult and community learning and development, further education, libraries, archives and information services and work-based learning.

In 2010, anyone who teaches courses that are publicly-funded will have to be qualified. This qualification introduces the knowledge and skills required by teachers to develop and deliver programmes, provide learning support and take the responsibility in managing the learning process in post-16 education.

Method of Tuition: This course is designed to be delivered in 30 hours of teaching time, with an additional 30 hours of assimilation, consolidation and assignment planning, development and submission. 5 days with another day allocated for practical micro teach and written assessments.

Course Objectives: To ensure students are confident and competent in basic educational delivery.
