

## MOD Team Medics to Offshore Medics

We recognize that the offshore medic qualification opens many doors and not just confined to the offshore industry. Historically there has been a very tight entry requirement for this course. With direct consultation with the HSE we have developed a training plan to enable medics who don't have a professional clinical qualification to develop into HSE Offshore Medics. This includes completing our 4 week Pre Hospital Medical Technician (RCS Ed) course followed by a 2 week placement. After successful completion medics can apply for the Offshore Medic course. This is an exciting opportunity that will undoubtedly enhance your medical knowledge and skills and may lead to new employment opportunities. Please speak to us for further information

### PARAMEDIC UPDATE

Medipro have now applied to the HPC for an approval visit for our new paramedic top-up course which is twinned with Northumbria University. This is a very unique opportunity for medical clinicians to develop into paramedics eligible for HPC registration. The initial entry requirement will be 3000 hours of acute or emergency patient contact within the last 5 years. The following is a breakdown of the course programme:

- Initial application
- Entrance exams
- APEL module
- 7 week classroom course
- 5 weeks placements
- 8 weeks independent study and revision
- Return to complete 1 day written assessments and hand in portfolios.

We are anticipating that the course will commence on the 4th June (subject to HPC approval)
