

## REMOTE AREA MEDICINE, RCS Ed COURSE OUTLINE

**Course Duration:** Five days

**Suitable candidates and pre requisitions:** This Remote Area Medicine course has been developed for students who already have experience and knowledge of Pre-Hospital Care. It focuses on clinical care with the added complication of remoteness in mind. Students will need to have prior medical experience before completing this course. These include doctors, nurses, paramedics and medics.

**Method of Tuition:** Interactive theoretical tuition combined with extensive practical sessions with scenarios that mirror their environment and assessments.

Elements of this course will be taught on the hill.

**Course Objectives:** Provide the skills and techniques to enable immediate care of trauma and critically ill patients within remote location across the globe.

- Shock, haemorrhage control (tourniquets, celox, quick clot) and fluids

- Head, neck, eye and dental issues
- Medical emergencies and Catheterisation
- Minor limb and back issues
- ALS and Diseases
- Animals and plants
- Extremes of weathers
- Altitude and mountains
